





Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of unstable windslab will be present mainly at the tops of steep North, North-East and East facing slopes and gullies above 1000m. Elsewhere the snowpack will be unconsolidated and generally stable. Any cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain cold with some light snowfall. Strong North-North-Westerly winds backing Westerly will gradually ease during Thursday

**Comments**

Unconsolidated snow in sheltered locations making walking arduous at times.  
Winds due to reduce during Thursday  
Remaining cold
