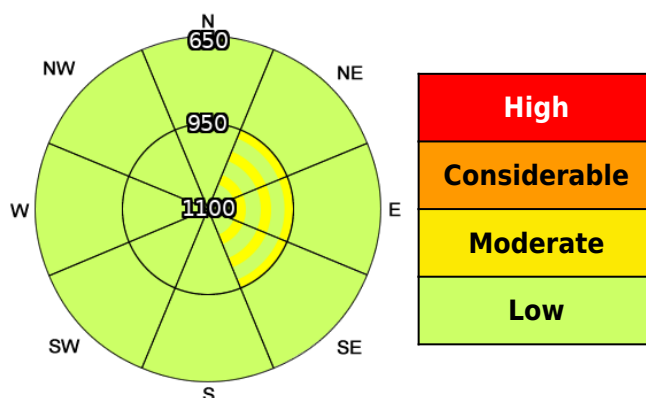
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised dry snow instability on North-East through East to South-East aspects above 950m. Most affected areas will be the tops of steep coire rims and gully exits. A thin covering of fresh snow in all other places where stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming very cold. Moderate to strong North North West winds. Some overnight snow showers tapering out by dawn.

Comments

Good stability in most places. Some localised instabilities high on coire rims and gully exits.
