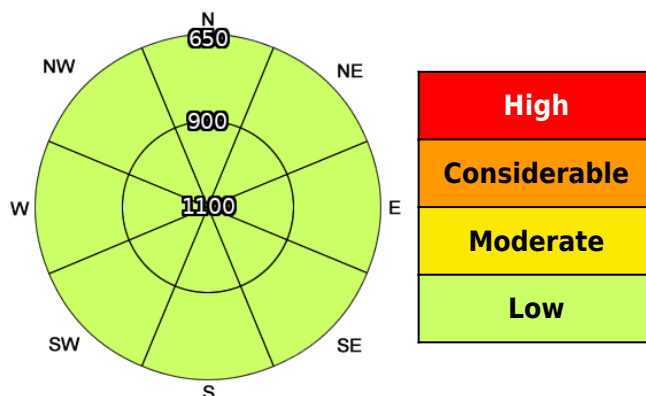
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small localised dry snow instabilities on North, NE and Easterly aspects will see some re-distribution during the day onto mainly North Westerly aspects. These areas are unlikely to be widespread and will be confined to a few steep, locations and gully top sidewalls in sheltered aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will maintain dry, cold conditions. Light South Easterly winds will strengthen, becoming East South Easterly during the day.

A dry, cold but cloudier day in prospect with strong winds on the tops.
