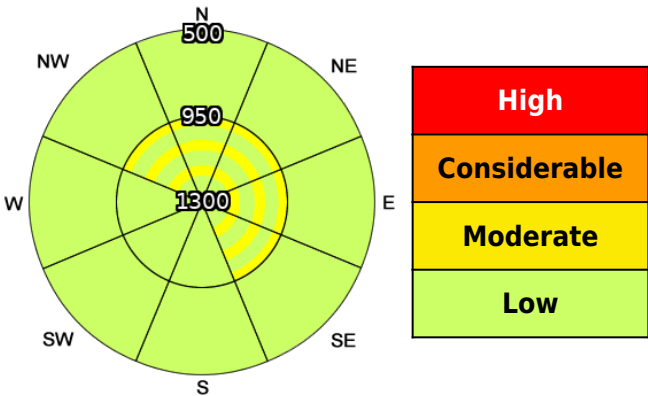
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some further development of moderately bonded windslab on North-West to North-East aspects mostly above 950 metres. Coire rims, gully exits and sheltered hollows will be especially affected. Deep localised moderately bonded windslab will remain on East to South-East aspects. Elsewhere there is a thin snow cover on bare ground. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the forecast period with moderate to strong South-South-Easterly winds easing through the night to become light to moderate Southerly by day break. The freezing level will be around 700 to 800 metres.
