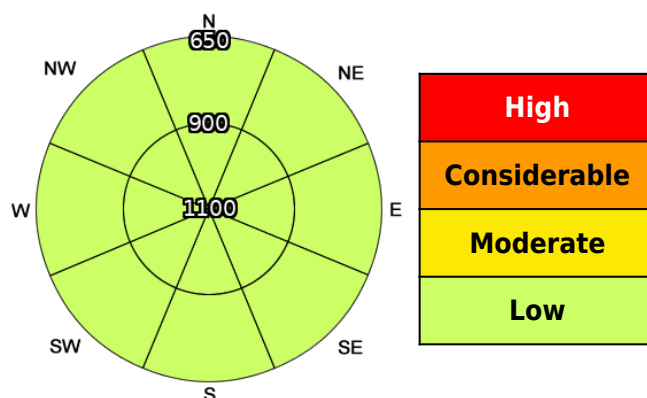
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The quantities of new snow are not expected to result in any significant change. Greatest accumulations lie on North-East through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. The snowpack is expected to remain sparse, with overall stability good in most locations and at all altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow showers during the morning will turn to sleet below 700 metres. The freezing level will then lower again to around 300 metres later in the day. South- Westerly winds will strengthen to moderate West-North- Westerly and North-West.
