

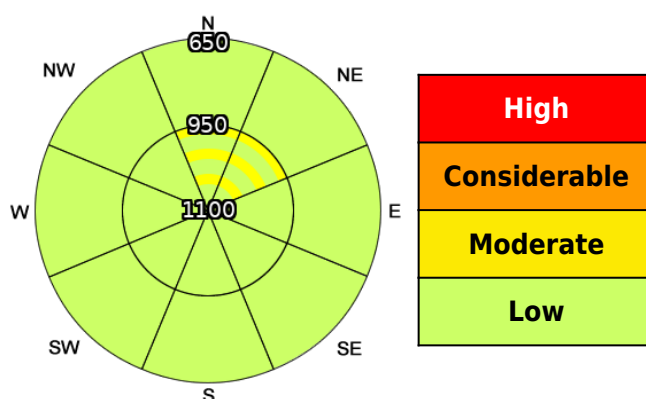

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 26/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability is expected to remain generally good, aided by the cooler conditions which will become more established during the day. Quantities of new snow are not expected to be significant, although some slab may begin to develop later in very sheltered gully tops, just below coire rims, on highest, steepest North to North Easterly aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

The Freezing levels will rise above the summits overnight, lowering slightly again during the day. Precipitation will be a mixture of rain and snow. The strong Westerly and South Westerly winds will ease moderate, towards the end of the day.
