
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older wet snowpack will freeze in the colder temperatures and be stable. Localised areas of fresh unstable windslab will develop with greatest accumulations on South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Fragile cornices will form above these aspects. Localised fresh accumulations on other aspects will generally be shallow and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A strong North-East wind backs North-North-West overnight and slowly eases through the day. Snow showers throughout, heaviest in the evening. The freezing level will be around 500 metres at the start of the period dropping to around 300 metres by the end of the afternoon.
