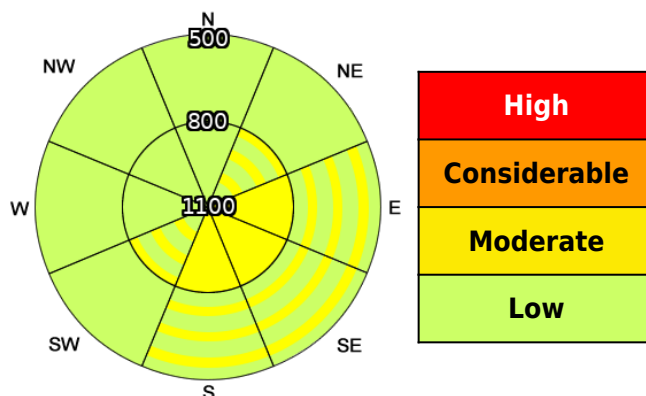

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist with some redistribution as the wind backs through the period. Greatest accumulations will be on East to South aspects above 800 metres. More localised deposits will be found in wind sheltered locations on other aspects and at lower elevations. The older snowpack will be frozen and stable. Fresh fragile cornices will be present above steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong North-North-West winds will become moderate and slowly back to West-South-Westerly. Mainly dry with some snow showers at the end of the afternoon. Freezing level around 300 metres.
