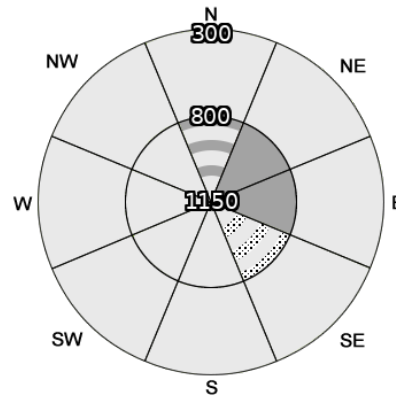

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snow where exposed will remain firm with an icy surface. Areas of windslab will form in sheltered areas such as summit gullies and slopes with North through East to South-Easterly aspect mainly above 800 metres. Where the accumulations attain significant depth stability will be poor. Cornices will be weakly bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight and on Tuesday will affect the area. Winds will be mainly West-South-Westerly occasionally strong overnight becoming fresh through the day. The freezing level will be around 300 metres lowering later in the day.

Comments

Ice is forming on rocks and paths at most levels.
