

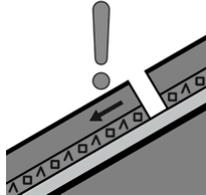

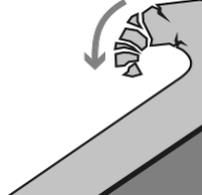

Wind Slab




Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deposits of unstable Windslab, from fresh snow and the redistribution of the existing soft snowpack, will be found mainly on North through East to South aspects above 900 metres. Steep gullies and corrie rims will be most affected. Fragile cornices will be found above these aspects. Slopes exposed to the wind will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate South-Westerly winds and snow showers throughout the period. The freezing level drops from around 400 metres to near sea level.

Comments

Remaining cold. Snow cover improving. Ice forming.
