

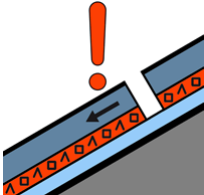

Avalanche Problems



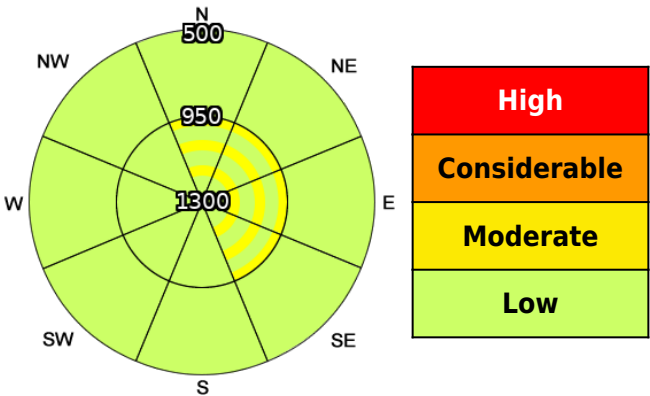
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some light drifting at higher levels. Localised windslab accumulations will be present on North through East to South-East aspects above 950 metres especially around coire rims and gully tops. Stability within the old firm windslab deposits will continue to improve. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with sunny spells and moderate South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will rise from 200 to 400 metres during the day.

Comments

Continuing to be very cold with more snowfall expected later in the week.
