

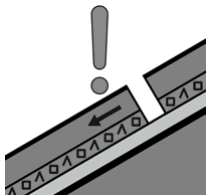

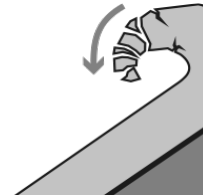

Wind Slab



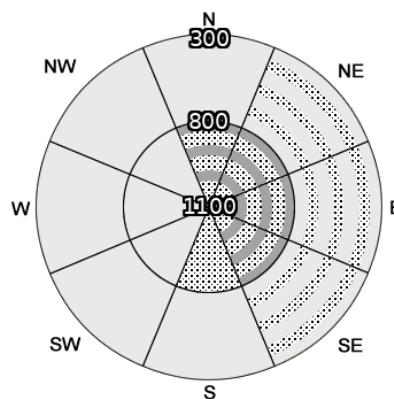
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Fresh windslab will be deposited throughout the period from redistribution of existing snow, and during the day from new snowfall. Gullies, scarp slopes and coire rims will be most affected. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. Instabilities will also persist in older windslab on East to South aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain freezing at all levels. Winds will be light to moderate mainly South-Westerly. It is expected to be dry overnight with snow showers during the day.
