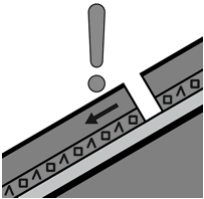


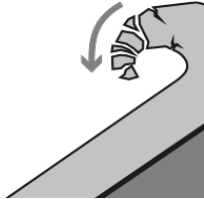

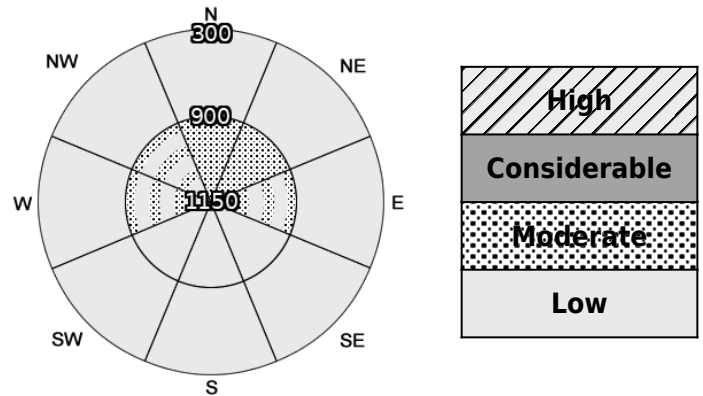
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older snowpack where exposed will be firm and icy. Recent snow lying at all levels will remain generally soft and unconsolidated. Deeper drifts and areas of moderate to weakly bonded windslab will exist in sheltered areas such as summit gullies and on slopes with a North through to Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres, gully exits and corrie headwalls will be particularly affected. Cornices will remain fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold and dry with moderate to fresh variable winds. Freezing at all levels.
