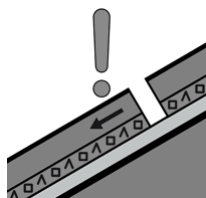

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 01/02/2019

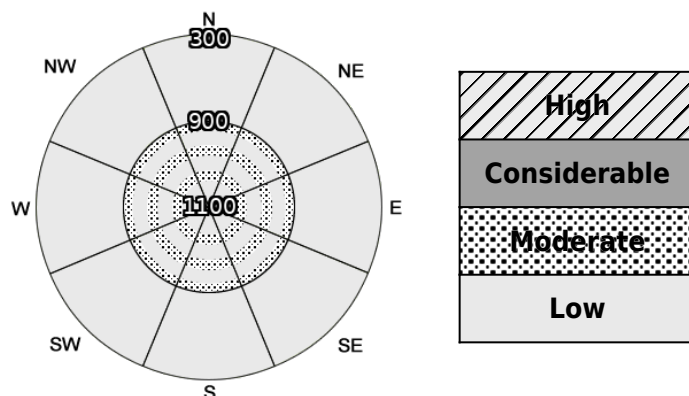
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instabilities will persist, particularly in very high shaded lee locations. Areas affected will primarily be high on steep North to East coire backwalls and gully exits above 900 metres. Some smallish cornices exist around coire rims, these remain fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mainly dry and cold throughout; a few snow showers will begin to affect the area again late afternoon. The winds will be light variable to start, then freshening North-West and Northerly by the end of the day. It will remain cold, with freezing at all levels.

Comments

Some consolidation particularly on sun affected aspects. Away from the paths any trail breaking can still encounter deep drifted conditions.
