

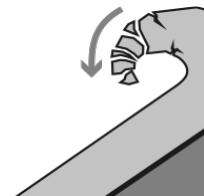

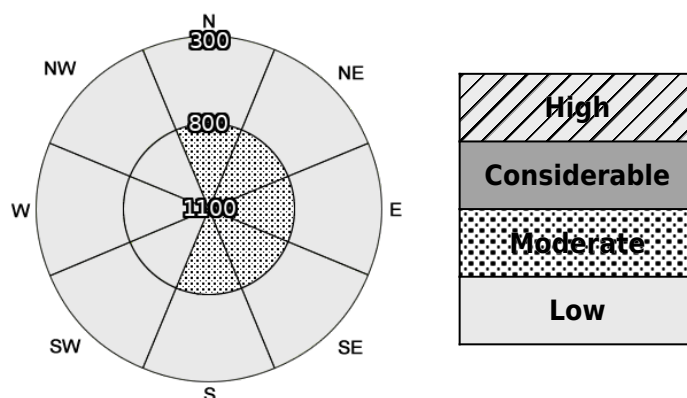
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh deposits combined with the partial redistribution of the existing snowpack will produce a complex pattern of windslab distribution. Pockets of poorly bonded windslab are likely on North through East around to Southerly aspects above 800 metres. However, these areas are not expected to be particularly extensive with the tops of slopes and gullies most affected. Some small and moderate sized cornices will exist. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a generally dry night there will be snow showers through the day. The freezing level will rise to around 600 metres. Moderate winds will be from the South or South-West.
