

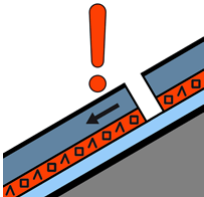

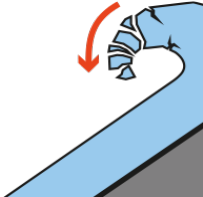
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



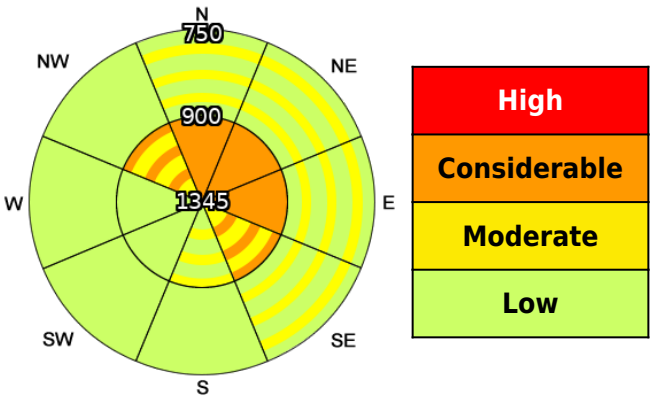
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited with greatest accumulations initially on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. During the period South-East and South aspects will also be affected. Fragile cornices will form above all these aspects. Stability in the older snowpack will improve in the slightly colder temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-West winds veer Westerly before dawn. Showers throughout falling as snow above around 750 metres. Freezing level around 900 metres.

Comments

There could be some quite large accumulations of snow in places sheltered from the strong winds. Better weather for Sunday and Monday.
