

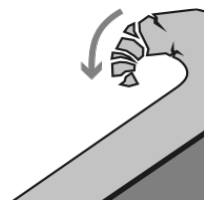

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to build in high wind sheltered areas. Greatest accumulations will be above 800 metres, primarily on North to East aspects, with some cross-loading later in the day on South to South-East. Some scouring on ridges and on exposed high ground. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will die away overnight, as the strong West-South-West winds ease South-South Westerly, then light Northerly by the end of the day. Slightly cooler with the Freezing level around 500 to 600 metres throughout.
