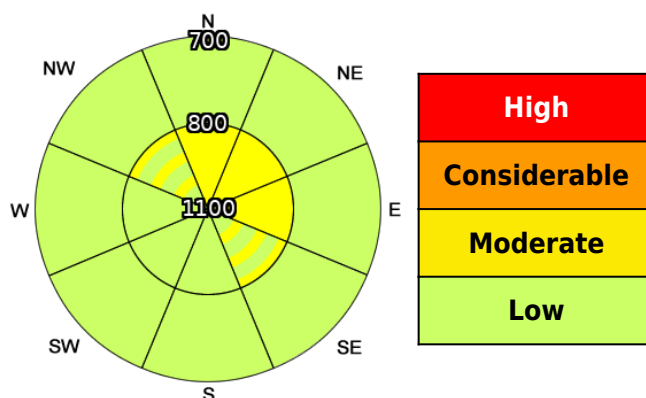

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Below 800 metres the snowpack will be well bonded and stable. Around coire rims and in steep gully exits areas of poorly bonded windslab will persist. Greatest accumulations are on North through East to South-Easterly aspects. Small new cornices which have developed on variable aspects around coire rims will remain suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mostly dry after the odd overnight snow shower. Freezing levels will remain between 400 and 700 metres throughout. Moderate North-Westerly winds will ease by morning, before strengthening again to a fresh South-Westerly during the afternoon.
