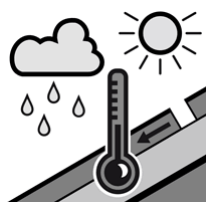


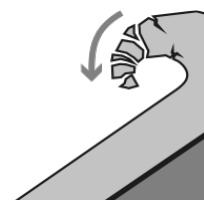

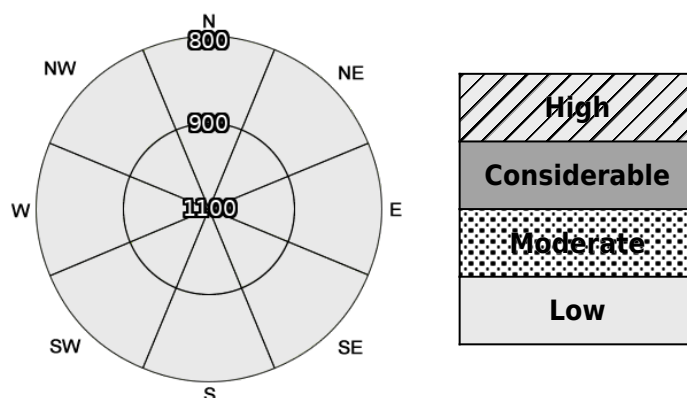

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will continue to deplete and be generally well consolidated in most locations. Some limited wet snow surface instabilities will persist on steepest slopes, any remaining cornice lines around coire rims above North through East to South East aspects remaining suspect during thaw conditions. An additional hazard of ice and rock fall still possible from all crag areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A strong South or South- Westerly airflow will continue to affect the area. The thaw conditions will prevail with Freezing levels remaining above summits throughout. Some clear, bright spells are expected to break through the cloud mid am. Dry and mild.
