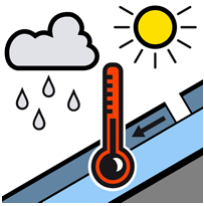


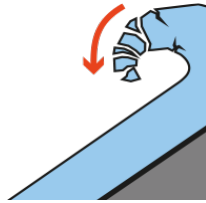

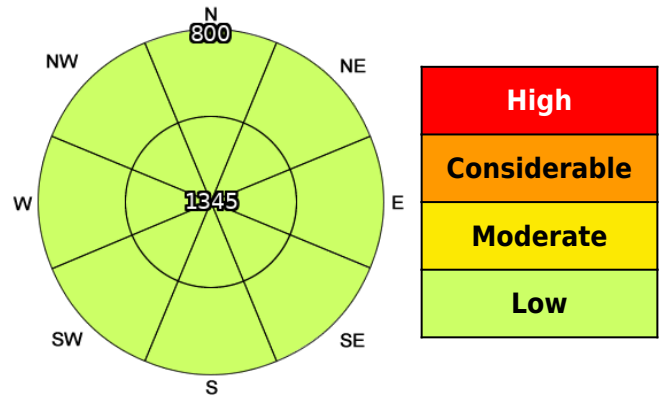
Wet Snow

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate and is generally stable. Any fresh snow deposits are not expected to be significant. Localised wet snow instabilities will be present on some steep aspects. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Strong South-South-West winds become moderate during the day. Showers, mainly through the night, will fall as snow on the higher summits for a time. The freezing level starts well above the summits dropping to around summit level during the day.
