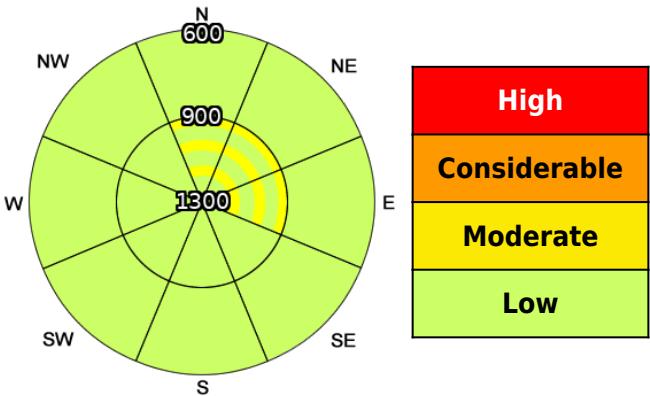
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As it turns cooler the old snowpack will become firm and more consolidated. Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will develop throughout the forecast period on steep Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Areas most affected will be in sheltered locations and especially around corrie rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleet will turn to snow showers above 900 metres on strong to gale force South veering South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fall to around 900 metres.
