

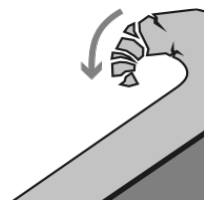

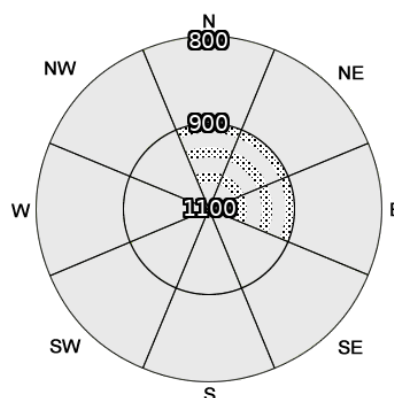
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some new windblown accumulations are expected on very sheltered North to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest accumulations will be in steepest gully exits and around coires rims where localised, new snow instabilities will exist. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A strong, showery South-Westerly airflow will affect the area. The Freezing level will be around 1000 metres with most persistent showers bringing fresh snow, during the day to around and just below summits.
