

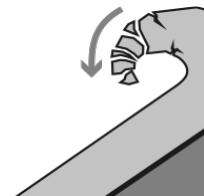

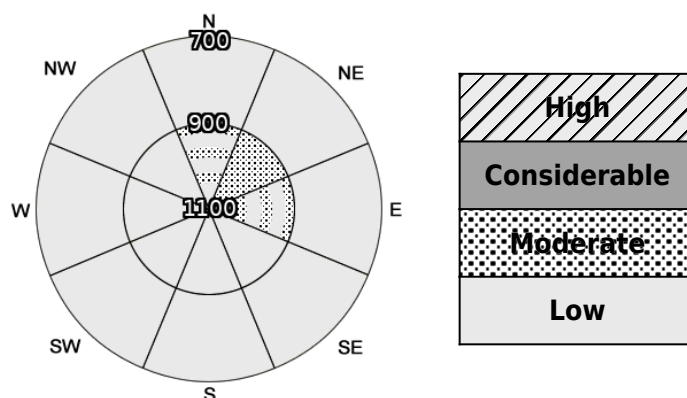
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further windblown accumulations are expected on very sheltered North to East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest accumulations will be in steepest gully exits and around coires rims where new moderately bonded windslab will exist. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further showery conditions will continue with snow showers throughout. The Freezing level will remain around 800 metres. Winds initially strong Westerly will ease a little, West-South-West before increasing again South, then South-East by end of the day.
