



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas. Greatest accumulations will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres, with North-West and South-East aspects also affected. The surface of the old snowpack where exposed will be re-frozen, hard and stable. Newly formed cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will generally be moderate to strong; West-South-Westerly overnight backing Southerly during the day and then strengthening. The freezing level will be around 900 metres. Showers through the period falling as snow above around 750 metres.
