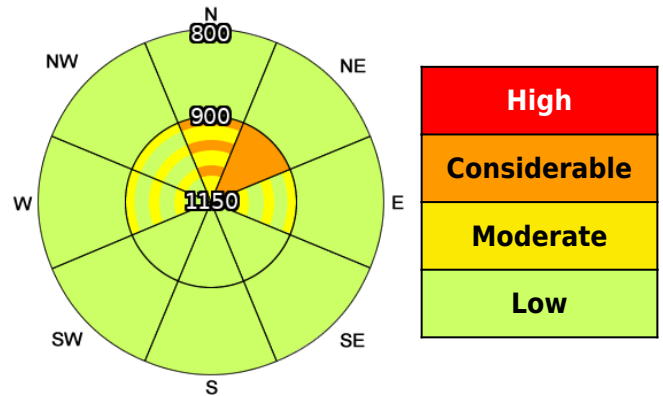

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Heavy overnight rain will saturate the snowpack giving a period of higher instability. Drier conditions later will allow a degree of stabilisation to occur. Wet snow instabilities will exist in sheltered gullies and on slopes with a North-West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Heavy rain overnight and into the morning will affect the area. The freezing level will rise well above the summits. Winds will be strong Southerly overnight veering South-Westerly remaining strong through the day.

**Comments**

Small slough/ class 1 area of avalanche debris noted below a North-Easterly aspect from 1000 metres. Hazard of rockfall will exist during the wet and mild conditions expected.
