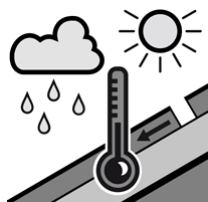


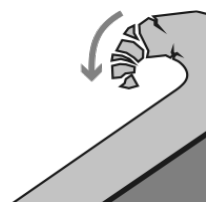

Avalanche Problems



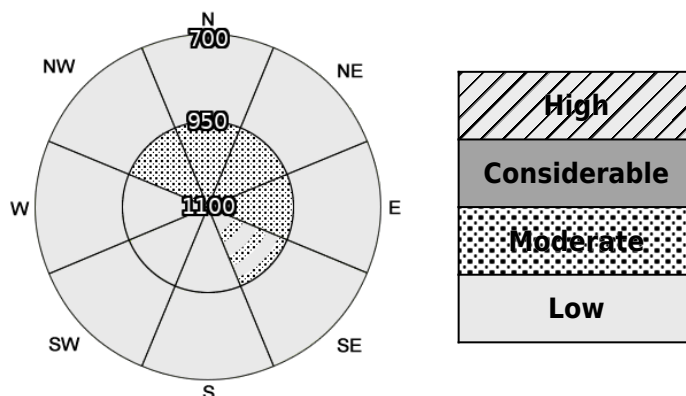
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Period of poor stability overnight on steep North-West through North to East aspects above 950 metres as snow turns quickly to rain. Wet snow instability will persist in these places for most of the day. Newly formed and older cornices will become wet and prone to collapse in the very mild, wet conditions. Falling ice and rocks potential hazards especially in the Inner Coire of Coire Ardair. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Colder temperatures and further snowfall for a time overnight then suddenly much milder and wet at all levels from midnight onwards. Winds initially moderate to strong South-Easterly, later South-Westerly.
