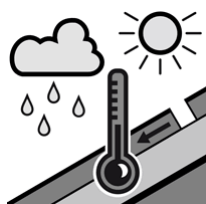


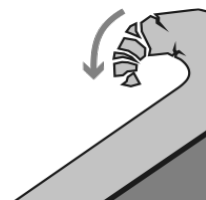

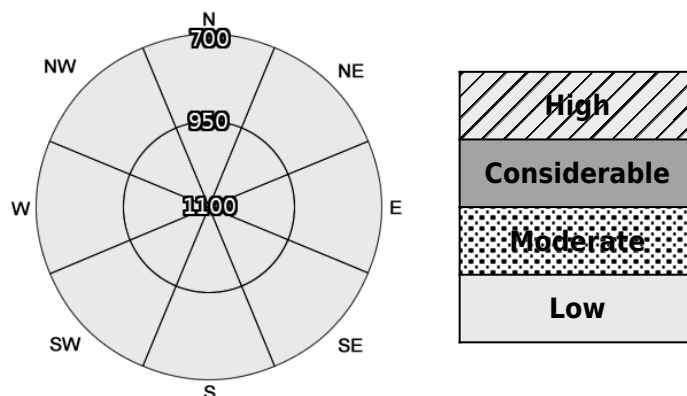
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some limited surface wet snow instability possible on very steep North-West through North to East aspects above 950m. General stability will continue to improve in most other locations. Remaining cornices will remain wet and suspect. Existing snowpack will become increasingly patchy in persistent thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A little overnight rain then dry. Cooler for a time but progressively milder from the early hours onwards. Moderate to strong South Westerly winds.

Comments

Thaw conditions expected to prevail right through until the end of February. Falling rocks and ice in the vicinity of very steep North to East-facing crags a consideration.
