

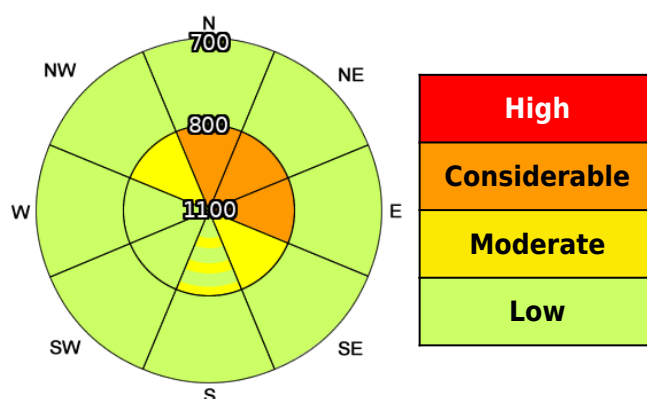

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remnants of any snowpack above 850 metres although moist will remain generally stable. Falling rocks and ice in the vicinity of very steep North to East-facing crags a consideration in thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It will continue mild and generally dry; a little light drizzle at first will quickly clear, although hill cloud is likely to affect mountain areas for much of the day. The winds will strong Southerly.
