

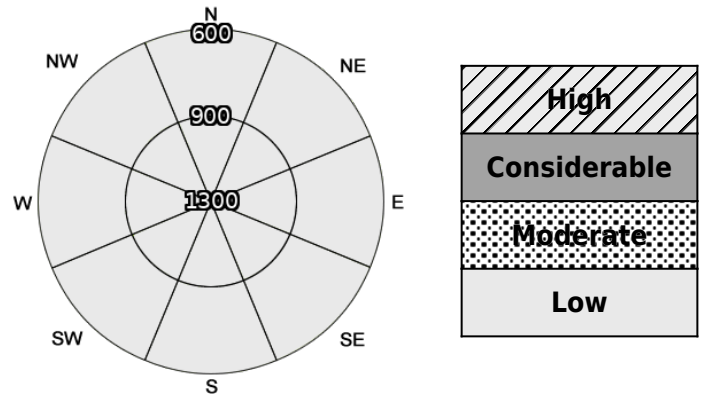

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 24/02/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to diminish in extent. Although soft and thawing the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable throughout. Greatest amounts are on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Although it will be cooler during the night the freezing level will remain above the summits, turning milder through the day. It will be dry throughout, strong South-West winds will ease at day break before increasing to Strong Southerly through the day.

Comments

Potential for loose boulders falling onto slopes below during the lean, mild conditions. Less windy on Sunday.
