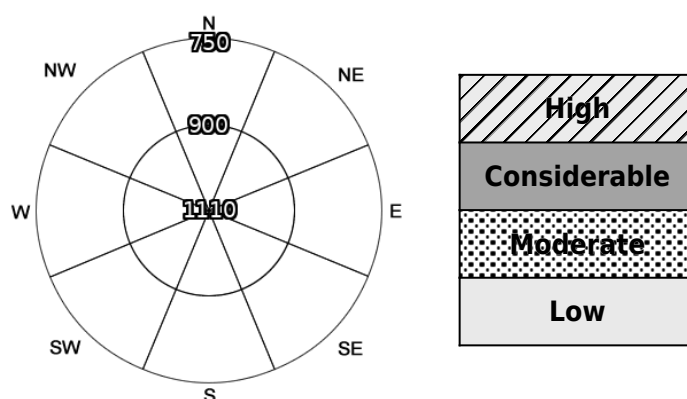


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 25/02/2019****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change within the limited snowpack which will remain well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts are on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be mild with dry cloudy conditions throughout. The freezing level will be well above the summits. Strong South to South-West winds will ease at day break and increase to moderate during the day.

Comments

The limited snowpack has currently firmed up, winter boots and kit still needed if venturing onto steeper snow covered slopes.
