

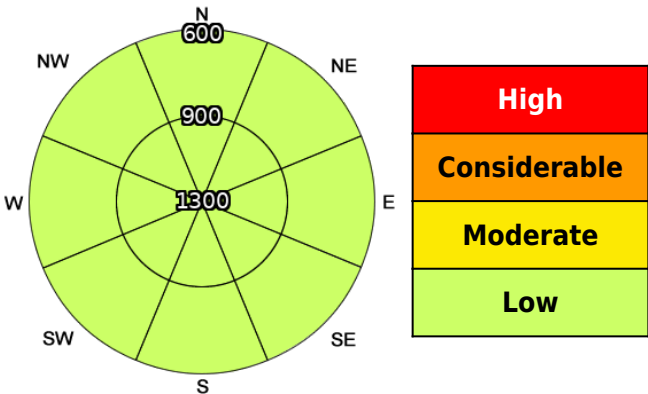

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 27/02/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The soft snowpack will continue to diminish in extent. Although moist throughout it will remain well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts are on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. Remnants of any cornices on Sun exposed slopes may present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry weather with sunshine during the day. The freezing level will remain above the summits. Light increasing to moderate Southerly winds will veer to the West-South-West during the afternoon.

Comments

A mild sunny day in prospect tomorrow. Potential for loose blocks falling onto slopes below.
