

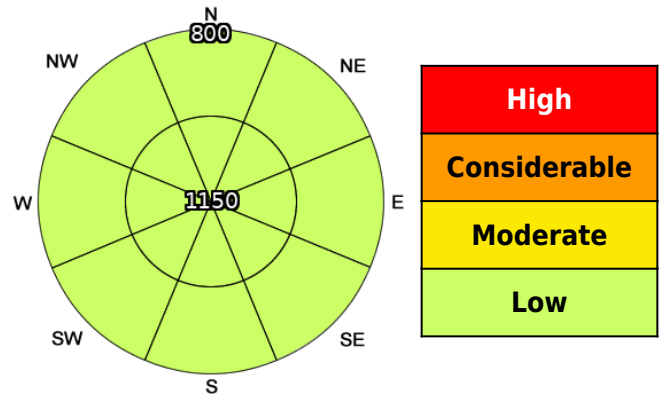
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 28/02/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain limited with the main accumulations in North to East facing corries and gullies above 900 metres. It will continue to thaw and consolidate, and stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and settled with moderate to fresh mainly East South East winds veering Southerly later. The freezing level will remain well above the summits lowering to around 1400 metres through the course of the day.

Comments

Remaining settled becoming a bit cooler than of late.
