

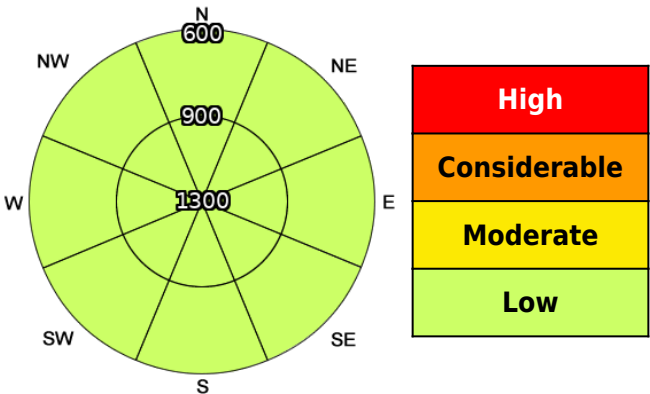

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The soft snowpack will continue to diminish in extent. Although moist throughout it will remain well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts are on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. Remnants of any cornices on Sun exposed slopes may present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions throughout. Variable light to moderate winds. The freezing level will be above the summits, cooler towards the end of the day.
