

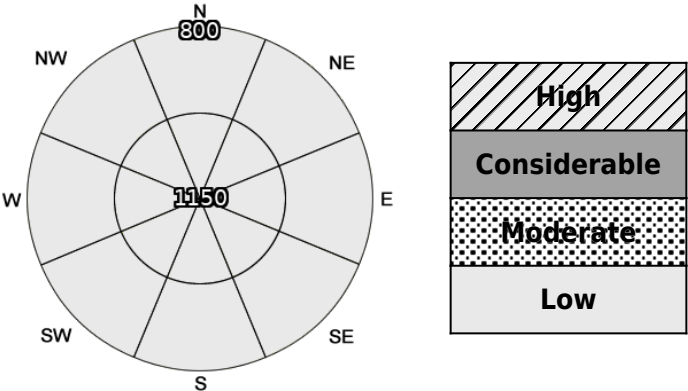

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 01/03/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain limited with the main accumulations in North to East facing corries and gullies above 900 metres. It will continue to consolidate with an icy surface possible in more sheltered locations. Stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and settled with moderate to fresh mainly Southerly winds. The freezing level will remain above the summits but overnight frosts will firm up the surface of the remaining snow.

Comments

Some mist and fog possible but mainly dry. Surface of snow in sheltered locations may be firm and icy through the day.
