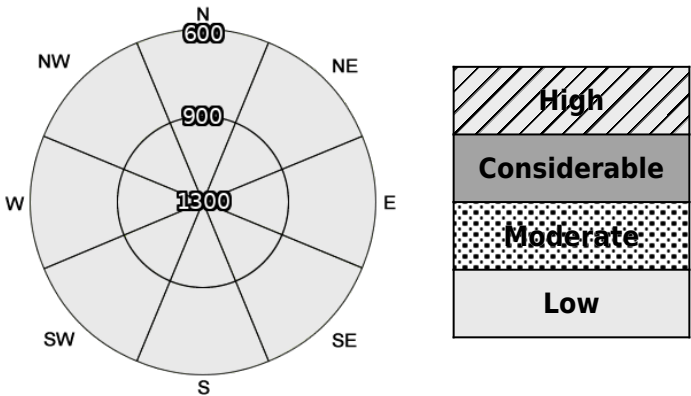
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old limited snow pack will be firm and stable. New deposits arriving from mid afternoon will accumulate shallow deposits in wind sheltered places on North-West to North-East aspects mostly above 1000 metres, amounts are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry with light South-Westerly winds overnight will gradually strengthen through the day becoming storm force Southerly later in the afternoon. Mostly dry with some precipitation later, falling as sleet or snow above 900 metres. Freezing levels fluctuating around summit altitudes.

Comments

A significant change in the weather with storm force winds and hill snow arriving later on Saturday. A return to winter.
