

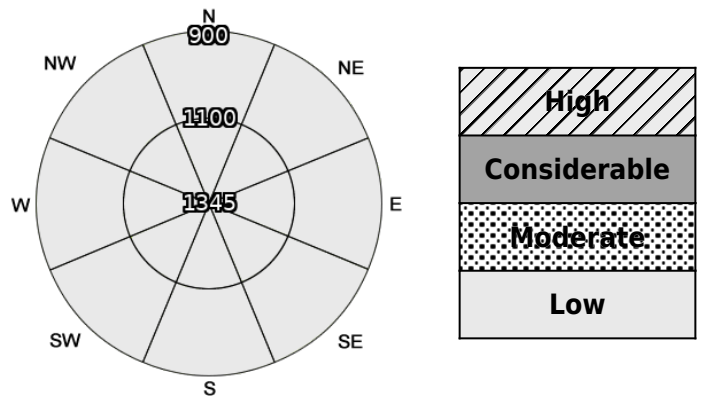

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will continue to thaw and will be stable. Some areas of fresh snow are expected on North-West to North-East aspects above 1100 metre. However, these are not expected to be significant and should be avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A change is expected in the weather. After a generally dry morning a band of precipitation will reach the area during the afternoon. This will fall as damp snow on the highest tops. The freezing level will be around 1300 metres. Strengthening winds will be from the South.

Comments

Turning colder with some snow expected overnight on Saturday night.
