

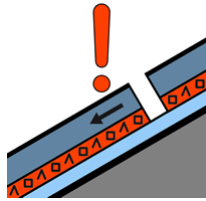

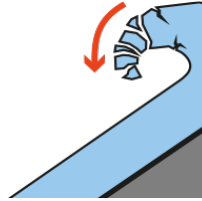
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



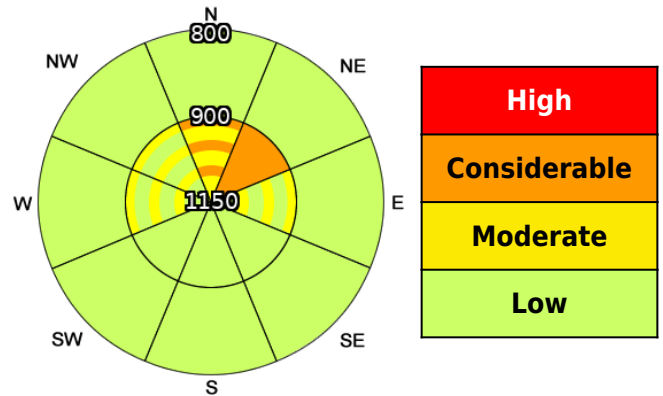
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderate amounts of new snow will form areas of weakly bonded windslab on slopes with a North to Easterly aspect mainly above 950 metres. Areas most affected will be sheltered gullies and North to East facing corrie headwalls in particular where old snow underlies. Fresh cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate new snow and fresh occasionally strong mainly Westerly winds will affect the area. The Freezing level will be around 800 metres.

Comments

New snow amounts are not expected to be great. Colder and less windy than of late.
