

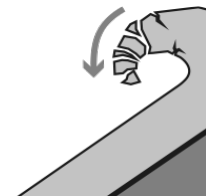

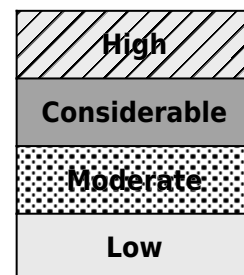
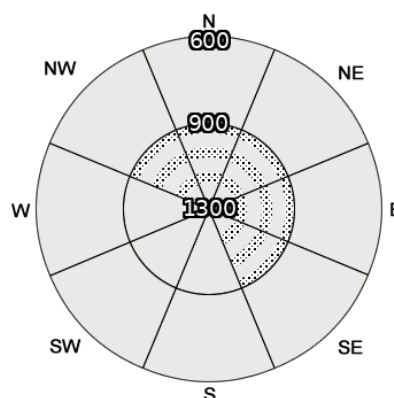

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Thin to shallow accumulations of snow will lie on most aspects above 700 metres. Deeper accumulations will be present on mostly wind sheltered North-West through North to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres, although soft these deposits will be generally stable. In the steepest locations instabilities will persist, with coire rims, steep gully exits, ridge flanks and scarp slopes most affected. Any new cornice development will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Winds moderate strength West-South-Westerly overnight will back, gradually becoming light East-South-Easterly by late afternoon. Freezing level around 700 metres. Some snow showers developing from midday with lying snow above 400 metres.

##### Comments

Remaining cold and wintry on the tops.
