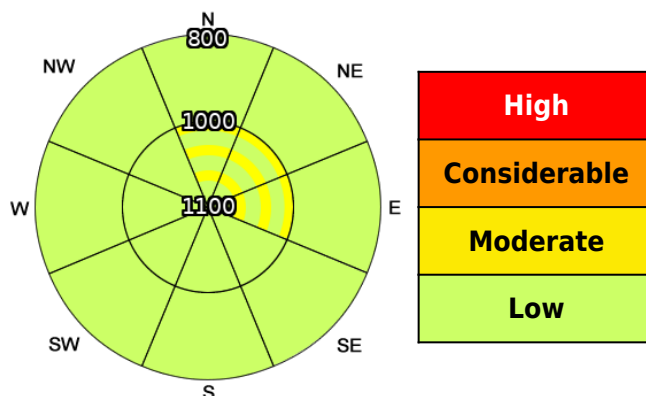

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting of snow will continue for a time overnight. New windslab will be present on most very steep North to East aspects above 950m. Localised poorer stability expected above 1000m in these locations some of which will be overhung by new, collapse prone cornices. A little new soft windslab may form on selected North West aspects above 1000m later but is expected to be limited in both depth and extent. Good stability in all locations below 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight but with some snow showers commencing later in the morning. Moderate West-South-Westerly winds easing and becoming East-South-Easterly later Easterly. Colder overnight then freezing at 650m during the day.

Comments

Colder with lighter winds on Tuesday.
