

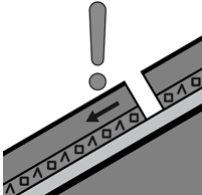

Avalanche Problems



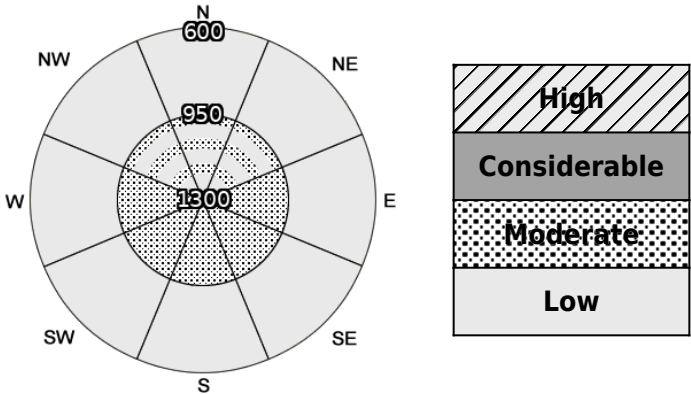
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in localised places on mainly East to Southerly aspects above 950 metres, especially in very steep and convex shaped terrain. New unstable accumulations of windslab will develop on South to Westerly aspects above 950 metres, mostly in isolated and steep wind sheltered locations where it gains any depth. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading. Elsewhere stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing level remaining at around 700 meters throughout the period. Winds light East-South-Easterly overnight strengthening to strong North-Easterly during the morning and for the rest of the forecast period. Precipitation will develop becoming more persistent through the day with snow lying mostly above 600 metres.
