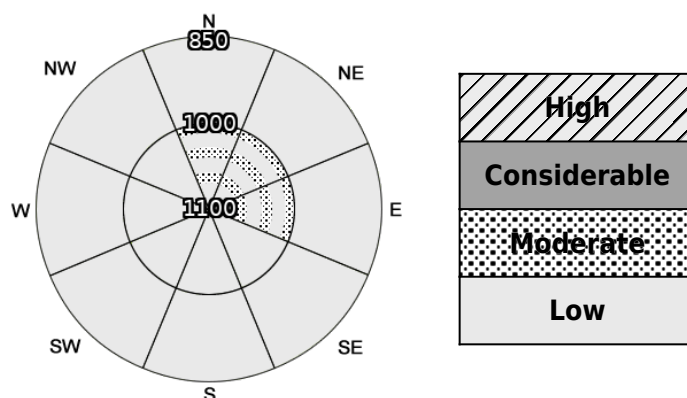
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Pockets of windslab will persist on very steep North to East aspects above 1000m. Later in the day there will be some re-distribution of recent deposits onto South-Westerly aspects, any development will primarily be on bare ground and is unlikely to achieve any significant depth. Good stability in all locations below 900m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight but with some snow showers later during the day. Easterly winds will freshen moderate to strong East North Easterly. The Freezing level will fluctuate around 700m.

Comments

Instabilities limited to localised areas, just below cornice line elevation.
