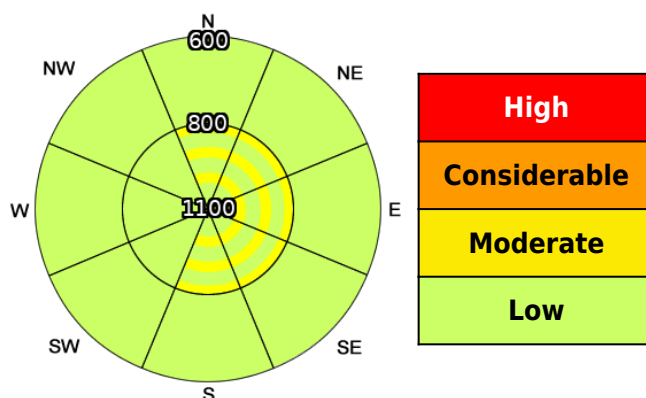
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further modest snow amounts above 600 metres. Where accumulations achieve depth above 800 metres in steepest, sheltered mainly South and South Easterly aspects new snow instabilities will exist. Many exposed hillsides and ridges will become scoured in the strong winds, all old accumulations will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be further snow showers throughout, falling progressively to around 400 metres. A cold strong Northerly airflow affect will affect the area from overnight.
