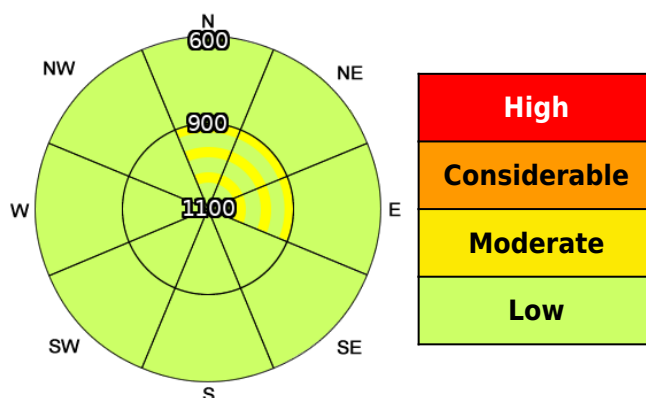

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New marginally stabilised windslab will begin to accumulate on steep North to East aspects above 900 metres. Most affected locations will be gully exit ramps and the top of coire backwalls where new snow instability will be localised. New minor cornice development will begin above these places. Scouring of recent windslab on South to West aspects expected as winds pick up. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold overnight with winds easing to light. Snow showers from the morning onwards on moderate to strong South-West winds.

Comments

Freezing at 200m overnight rising to 800m by the end of Friday.
