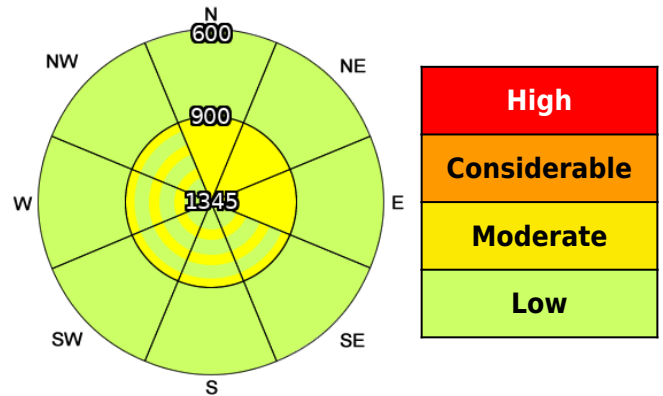
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Through the day shallow areas of fresh windslab will be deposited on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Older deposits of windslab will remain in sheltered locations on other aspects. In general deposits of windslab are not expected to be extensive, and should be generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry and cool overnight with a freezing level of around 600 metres. Through the day there will be some snow and the freezing level will rise to around 700 metres. Moderate Southerly winds will veer to the South-West.

Comments
