

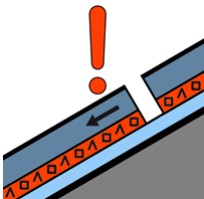

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 09/03/2019

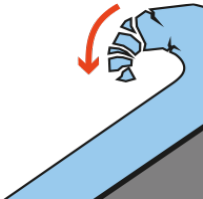
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



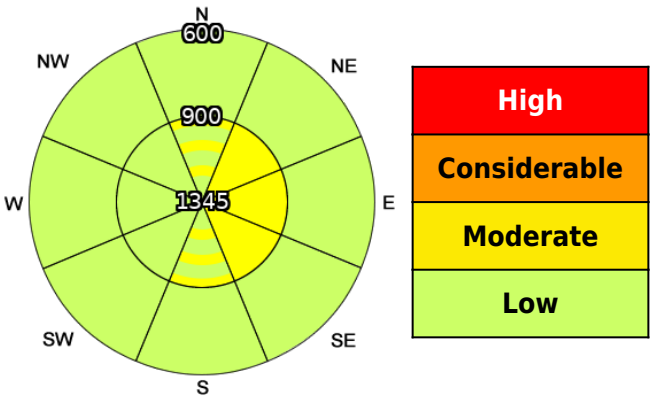
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will develop overnight and during Saturday. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900 metres. Other sheltered locations will also be affected. Exposed old snow will be frozen and stable. Fresh cornices will form above all Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds overnight decreasing during Saturday. Snow showers above 400 metres throughout the period.

Comments

Strong winds overnight are expected to ease by morning. Windslab development will continue through out the period.
