



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-East and East aspects above 900 metres. The changing wind direction will also form windslab on Northerly aspects earlier in the period and South-Easterly aspects later. Fresh cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate Southerly winds overnight, increasing and veering to the west during Sunday. Snow showers above 300 metres.
