

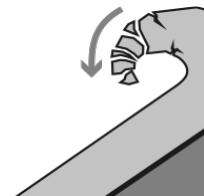

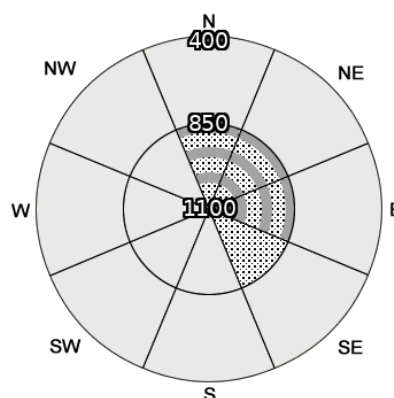
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaker, marginally bonded windslab will continue to build and become more extensive primarily on very steep North through to East aspects above 850 metres. New cornice development expected above very steep coire backwalls and gully tops of the same aspects. Better stability on ridges and recently wind scoured areas. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be further snow showers throughout, some heavy at times. Strong, generally South-Westerly winds. Remaining cold with the Freezing level staying below 400 metres.
