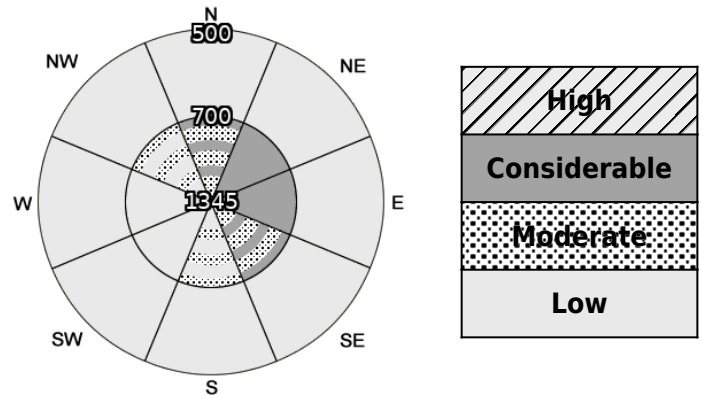

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist and continue to develop through the period. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. Slopes exposed to the wind will generally be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds overnight will ease and back Southerly during the day, increasing again at the end of the afternoon. Snow showers throughout. The freezing level will rise from 400 metres to around 800 metres.
