

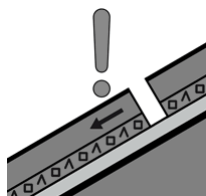

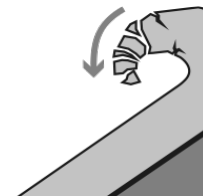

Wind Slab



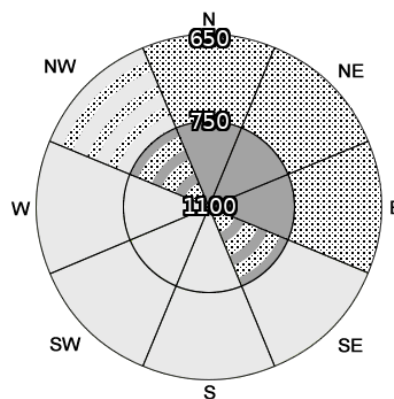
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weak windslab will gain greater depth and become more widespread on all steep lee slopes above 750m. Most affected will be North to East and some very wind sheltered North-West and South-East aspects where avalanches are likely. All new cornices above these locations will grow becoming very weak and collapse prone. Very poor stability indeed overnight. Better stability on all ridges and recently wind exposed areas. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snowfall forecast for our area especially overnight. Freezing level rising briefly to 900m overnight then much colder. Strong or very strong Southerly, later South Westerly winds.
