

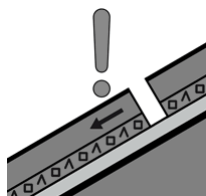

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 17/03/2019

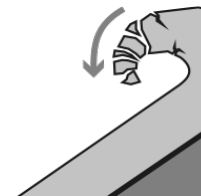

Wind Slab



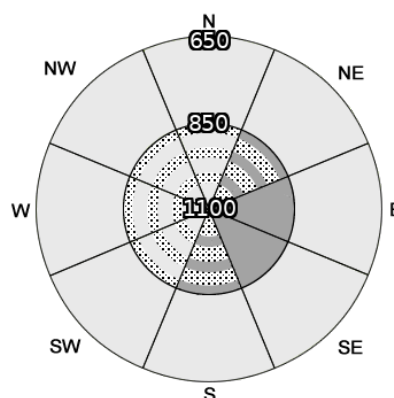
Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weak windslab will be present on steep East to South aspects above 850 metres. Residual poor instability on steeper North-East facing gullies and coire backwalls, though this will be localised and confined to highest locations above 950 metres. Most recently formed cornices will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers throughout. Mainly North-West winds increasing to moderate from the early hours. Cold.

##### Comments

Limited visibility in flat, white light at all altitudes on Saturday.
